Includes text book; workbook; stethoscope/BP cuff; pen light; CPR card and CPR key chain. Students will be advised of the dates to take the State Practical and Written Exams. The fee and completion of these are the responsibility of the students.

**NOTE: Commencing with the second week of class, the tuition is understood by the applicant to be non-refundable. Should a student drop out the first week, a fee of \$90.00 will be retained to cover the cost of the textbook; workbook and administration.**

The EMT-Basic course will be conducted on consecutive Tuesdays and Thursdays commencing Tuesday, September 23 from 6:00 pm till 10:00 pm at EMS Headquarters, 448 Sport Hill Road, and every other Saturday (time to be determined). The course will be completed Saturday, December 13<sup>th</sup>. Class will start promptly at 6:00 pm and each student is expected to be in attendance prior to that time. Early registration is recommended, as class size is limited.

Robert Slivinski, EMT-P, EMS-I, AHA will be the EMT-Basic Lead Instructor. The EMT-B course follows the guidelines of the State of Connecticut, Department of Public Health, and Office of Emergency Medical Service. It includes ambulance ride time—all of which is designed to prepare an individual for the state certification practical and written exams for Emergency Medical Technician-B. A hands-on approach will be emphasized.

Upon successful completion of the EMT-Basic course and subsequent certification by the State of Connecticut, all members of this course will have the option to receive tuition reimbursement after one (1) year of service with the Easton Volunteer Emergency Medical Service, as well as to receive a tax abatement (honorarium) payment if he/she:

- a. Joins the Easton Volunteer Emergency Medical Service and serves one year, with a 6-hour shift commitment per week plus adherence to mandated training and/or OSHA requirements as necessary. Seniority in shift assignments is observed.
- b. An applicant for membership in the Easton Volunteer Emergency Medical Service must meet successfully the requirements of the EVEMS personnel policies.
